

## **Al-Sham Scholarship Terms and Conditions**

The following terms and conditions outline the guidelines and expectations for recipients of the Al-Sham CLP Scholarship offered by The Mulkern Foundation/Muwasat Mulkern Ltd. Applicants are required to carefully read and understand the conditions before applying for the scholarship:

1. **Eligibility Criteria:**
  - Applicants must identify as female.
  - Applicants must be legal residents of Syria, Lebanon, The Palestinian Territories, or Egypt.
  - Applicants must demonstrate a minimum B2 level of proficiency in English, either through certification or a successful interview conducted by the awarding body.
2. **Application Process:**
  - Applicants are required to submit a brief letter of application outlining their interest in pursuing English teacher training and their reasons for applying for the scholarship.
3. **Scholarship Revocation:**
  - Recipients of the scholarship must complete the assigned coursework within the stipulated time frame.
  - The use of generative AI or any form of plagiarism in coursework assignments is strictly prohibited.
  - The scholarship can be revoked if the recipient fails to complete the assigned coursework or is found to have engaged in plagiarism.
  - The awarding body, The Mulkern Foundation/Muwasat Mulkern Ltd, reserves the right to revoke the scholarship at its discretion.
4. **Responsibilities of Scholarship Recipients:**
  - Recipients must adhere to the rules and regulations of the English teacher training course.
  - Recipients are expected to maintain academic integrity and honesty throughout the duration of the course.
  - Recipients must actively participate in all required activities and assignments.
  - Recipients should inform the awarding body of any changes in personal circumstances that may affect their ability to fulfill the requirements of the scholarship.
5. **Notification and Communication:**
  - Recipients will be notified of their selection for the scholarship via email or other appropriate means of communication.
  - All communication regarding the scholarship will be conducted through the contact information provided by the applicant.
6. **Legal Obligations:**
  - The Mulkern Foundation/Muwasat Mulkern Ltd reserves the right to make changes to the terms and conditions of the scholarship without prior notice.
